Student Bike Rental Policies 2016

- The semester rental program is for Miami University Students only.
- The program provides rentals for full semesters only. No partial semesters.
- Bikes subject to availability and BikeWise reserves the right to substitute bikes as needed.
- Cost is \$120 per semester. A \$100 deposit is required. We will take credit card information at that time as well, but this is only used if the bike is lost or stolen. Only one deposit per bike required, regardless of number of semesters chosen as rental term. Any damage to the bike not the result of normal wear is deducted from the deposit. Any overage is charged at the time of repair. If no damage is incurred during the rental, the full deposit will be returned when the bike is returned in satisfactory condition at the end of the rental term. Damage is determined at the sole discretion of BikeWise.
- A high-quality lock will be provided along with a key. BikeWise retains a second key. Renter should photograph or otherwise record the key number. Should a replacement be required, BikeWise will charge \$20 plus tax for a replacement, or the renter can obtain a replacement themselves at <http://www.kryptonitelock.com/en/customer-service/order-keys.html> for \$10 plus tax.
- Front and rear LED lights will be provided in compliance with Ohio Vehicle Laws. It is the renter's responsibility to make sure they are turned on when necessary.
- Helmets are not provided but may be purchased. Ohio does not have a helmet law for bicycles.
- Bikes are due back at BikeWise Oxford no later than 4PM on the Saturday at the end of Finals Week. Failure to return bike on time will result in the full charge for the entire package, less deposit, approximately \$400, depending upon model of bike rented.
- Renter is fully responsible for the protection and maintenance of the bike during the rental period. BikeWise Oxford will provide maintenance and repairs due to wear during the rental period at no charge. These include proper tire inflation, repair of simple flat tires, lube on chains and proper function of brakes and derailleurs as well as any repairs covered under manufacturer's warranty.
- What isn't covered:
Bent wheels, bent frame, bent front forks, bent seatpost or seat frame rails, bent handlebars, tires with large cuts, pinch flats (sign of insufficient inflation or impact) rusted chains, damage from a wet bike being left in freezing temperatures or other types of damage determined by BikeWise as not being the result of normal wear.
